


BYLAW No. 1(79)


A Bylaw of the Town of Outlook to control the protection of water supplies from chemical residue.

As provided for under the authority of Section 229(2) of the Rural Municipalities Act (or Section 201 (15) of the Urban Municipalities Act), the Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall fill any chemical spray apparatus at the following public water sources
 - a) water storage and treatment plant in Outlook.
2. A person who infringes any provisions of this Bylaw or fails to comply therewith is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00.


