

BYLAW NO. 2(96)

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A LANE.

WHEREAS Section 156 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, allows a municipality to permanently close any street or lane vested in the Crown with the prior written consent on the Minister of Highways and Transportation **AND** after having given the public notice of the proposed closure(s);

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to **AND** Council has given the required public notice of the proposed closure(s);

THEREFORE, the Council of the **Town of Outlook** in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts:

- (1) To permanently close the following public highway described as:

Firstly: All that portion of the North South lane in Block 19, Outlook, Saskatchewan Plan G411 lying to the South of a line joining a point on the East Boundary of Lot 12, Block 19, Plan G411 distant Southerly 20 feet from the North East corner with a point on the Western Boundary of Lot 21, Block 19, Plan G411 at a point distant Southerly 20 feet from the North West corner of said Lot 21, and


Secondly: The lane in Block 19, Outlook, Saskatchewan Plan 91-S-09066.

- (2) That the **ADMINISTRATOR** undertake such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw.


