

BYLAW NUMBER 3(74)

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK AUTHORIZING COUNCIL OF  
THE SAID TOWN TO ENTER INTO A HOUSING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS provision is made in the Saskatchewan Housing Corporation Act, 1973, enabling the Council of any Municipality, subject to the approval of the Local Government Board, to enter into a Housing Agreement or Agreements as provided by Section 26 of the said Act, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Outlook deems it expedient to undertake a housing project within the terms of the said Act:

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council of the Town of Outlook enacts as follows:

(1) That the proposed agreement hereunto annexed and marked as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw and which is deemed to be part of this Bylaw, being a tripartite agreement
