

BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY

Section 12, *The Heritage Property Act*, R.S.S. 1978, c.H-2.2, as amended

BYLAW No. 11(2003)

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK TO DESIGNATE A SITE AS MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of *The Heritage Property Act* authorize the Council of a Municipality of enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Outlook has determined that the lands and premises known as:

the Canadian Pacific Railway Station

and located at:

100 Railway Avenue East in the Town of Outlook, Province of Saskatchewan

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, palaeontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Outlook has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a. Served on the owners of said property
- b. Served on the Registrar of Heritage Property;
- c. Registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate Land Titles Office [Information Services Corporation]; and,
- d. Published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Town of Outlook;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Outlook enacts as follows;:

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:
Lot 5A, Block 1, Plan 92-S-18606, Extension 0, as described on Certificate of Title 92-S-44237

The reasons for the designation as follows:

- a. This Building is the former Canadian Pacific Railway Station
- b. To recognize the importance of the former station building as an economic and transportation hub of the area
- c. To preserve and protect the architectural design and styling of the building which was typical of railway stations of its era

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2. The Municipal Administrator/Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of Designation to be:
 - a. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office [Information Services Corporation]
 - b. served on the owners of said property.

3. The Municipal Administrator/Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.
