
**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK TO PROVIDE FOR THE  
PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A LANE.**

**WHEREAS** Section 156 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 allows a municipality to permanently close any street or lane vested in the Crown with the prior written consent of the Minister of Highways and Transportation AND after having given the public notice of the proposed closure;

**AND WHEREAS** the Minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to AND Council has given the required public notice of the proposed closure;

**THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts:

- (1) To permanently close the following public highway described as:  
  
All that portion of Lane shown on Registered Plan 69S05199.
- (2) That the Administrator undertake such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw.
