BYLAW NO. 8(2001)

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH ASSESSMENT APPEAL FEES

The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Where an appellant gives a notice of appeal pursuant to Section 251 of **The Urban Municipality Act, 1984**, the appellant shall, at the time of filing the notice of appeal, or at any other time within the 30-day period as mentioned in subsection 251(3) of **The Urban Municipality Act, 1984**, pay a fee to the Town of Outlook.
2. Where an appellant is successful in whole or in part on an assessment or classification appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the council of the Town of Outlook shall refund the fee that was submitted by the appellant to the Town of Outlook.
3. The assessment appeal fees referred to in the above sections shall be set out in Schedule 1, attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
4. Pursuant to Section 251.1 of **The Urban Municipality Act, 1984**, where an appellant fails to pay the appeal fee as set out in Schedule 1, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
5. Bylaw No. 3(97) is hereby repealed.



Residential	\$50.00
Seasonal Residential	\$50.00
Commercial and Industrial	\$90.00
