BYLAW NO. 13(1999)

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE THAT HOME-BASED BUSINESSES ARE NOT TO BE ASSESSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 240(2) OF THE URBAN MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1984.

The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the following definition will apply, "**Home-based business**" means a business whose premises are located on land or within a building where the land or building is primarily used for residential purposes.
2. That home-based businesses be exempt from the requirement of assessment for business tax purposes, and that these businesses should be licensed under the Town of Outlook licensing bylaw.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2000.
