BYLAW NO. 06 (2023)

A BYLAW TO IMPOSE PENALTIES FOR THE BREACH OF THE PROVISIONS OF ANY BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK

The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- This Bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalties Bylaw" of the Town of Outlook
- 2. Any individual or corporation found guilty on summary conviction of a breach of any Bylaw of the Town of Outlook from which no penalty is provided in said bylaw shall be liable to a fine of:

Two Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the first offence; Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the second offence; Two Thousand dollars (\$2000.00) for the third and each subsequent offence

- 3. This bylaw is passed in recognition that Section 381 of *The Municipalities Act* clearly states the fines for contravention of *The Act* and it states the maximum fines should no penalty be provided for in bylaw of the Town.
- 4. That Bylaw 06(1996) be repealed.
- This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
