## BYLAW NO 01(2017)

## A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS

The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Civic Addressing Bylaw.
- 2. A uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings is hereby established.
- 3. A separate number shall be assigned for each subdivided lot or combination of lots that form a single lot for the purpose of a house or building.
- 4. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.
- 5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this bylaw, upon request of the owner of a property situated on a corner, the number assigned may be specific to the flankage.
  - In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear the same number extended with a letter of the alphabet beginning with the letter "A" and proceeding with as many as are required.
- Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 7. The Administrator (or other designated person) shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
  - Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable as per the General Penalty Bylaw.
