## BYLAW NO. 2(97)

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A LANE.

WHEREAS: Section 156 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, allows a municipality to permanently close any street or lane vested in the Crown with the prior written consent of the Minister of Highways and Transportation AND having given the public notice of the proposed closure:

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to AND Council has given the requested public notice of the proposed closure:

THEREFORE, The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts:

(1) to permanently close the following public highway described as:

All that portion of lane, Plan 70-S-13835, in the Town of Outlook, lying to East of the production Northerly of the Westerly limit of Parcel "L" shown on Plan 82-S-00888; as the said plans are of record in the Land Titles Office for the Saskatoon Land Registration District.

(2) That the Administrator undertake such other things necessary to effect the intent of the Bylaw.
