BYLAW NO. 16(97)

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES

Whereas the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires; therefore,


The Council of the Town of Outlook, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. A fee of \$5.00 per tire, which includes the GST, will be charged for depositing scrap tires at the municipal owned or operated landfill located within the boundaries of the Municipality.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless the location has been specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to (the penalty provided for by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality or other specified penalty).
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on August 1, 1997.


