ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check including Vulnerable Sector Check (Ages 18+)
- A valid National Lifesaving Award (NLA) Certificate issued by The Life Saving Society of Canada
- A current St. John Ambulance Standard First Aid Certificate and CPR C, Red Cross Standard First Aid Certificate and CPR C or Life Saving Society Aquatic Emergency Care Certificate

COMPETENCIES:

- Respect and support all staff members to project a positive, professional atmosphere at all times, whether on deck or not
- Reliable, hardworking, independent and a team player
- Inter-personnel communication skills
- Ability to work with other members of the team at a professional level
- Ability to remain calm in all situations
- Demonstrate dedication to the position and community
- Act as a competent person with regards to health and safety
- Work evening and weekend shifts
- Ability to work with the public in a respectful and professional manner

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensuring the safety of all patrons
- Follow all procedures as set out in the Swimming Pool Manual
- Maintain an accurate Log Book
- Follow proper safety procedures when working with pool chemicals
- Assist in the completion of daily maintenance of pool and pool area as required
