

JOB DESCRIPTION: JUNIOR LIFEGUARD

REPORTS TO: Pool Manager

JOB SUMMARY: Reporting to the Swimming Pool Manager and/or Assistant Pool Manager, this position holds the primary responsibility of ENSURING THE SAFETY OF ALL PATRONS and assisting the Manager in the seamless operation of the pool. Secondary and Tertiary responsibilities are listed, but not limited to the following.

COMPETENCIES:

- INSURING THE SAFETY OF ALL PATRONS!!
- Follow the direction of the supervising Senior Lifeguard
- Follow all procedures as set out in the Swimming Pool Manual.
- Maintain an accurate Log Book.
- Follow proper safety procedures when dealing with chemicals.
- Assist in the completion of daily maintenance of pool and pool area as required.

JOB DUTIES:

- Reports all public complaints/concerns to manager on duty for proper disposition.
- Attend all in-service events.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Satisfactory completion of all certifications as required by the Swimming Pool Act 1999
 - A valid Bronze Cross Certificate issued by The Life Saving Society of Canada;
 - A current St. John Ambulance Standard First Aid Certificate, Red Cross Standard
 First Aid Certificate or Life Saving Society Aquatic Emergency Care Certificate;
 - A current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation C-Level Certificate.
 - Successful completion of the Youth Worker's Certificate (if under the age of 16)
- Respect and support all staff members to project a positive, professional atmosphere at all times, whether on deck or not.
- While on the premises, all cell phones, MP3/iPods must be powered off and stowed.
- The Swimming Pool phone is for business/emergency use and is not to be used for personal calls
