BYLAW NO. 12(96)

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF OCCUPANTS OF TRAILERS,
MOBILE HOMES AND PORTABLE SHACKS

The council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

License Registration

1. The occupant of every trailer, mobile home or portable shack used for residential purposes within the confines of the Town of Outlook shall within five days of the expiration of thirty days from the date of entry into the Town, register such trailer, mobile home or portable shack with the Administrator of the municipality, and obtain a license.

Fee Schedule

2. The schedule of fees for a license for a trailer, mobile home or portable shack used for residential purposes shall be as follows:

Land Assessment X 2 X Prior Years Mill Rate

Plus

Improvement Assessment X Prior Years Mill Rate

The Sum is then Divided by 12 to determine the monthly fee.

Penalty

3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw, shall be subject to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of The Town.

Bylaw Repealed

4. Bylaw No. 9(83) is hereby repealed.

Effective Date

5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of July, 1996.
