

Topic: Public Works Report April 8th 2022

Transportation:

-Over the past month, we have seen snow ridges and piles all over town melting, we pumped any known low areas or any frozen storm sewer issues as needed. Since then all snow has melted for the most part and standing water has dried up in any problem areas.

-We have begun patching potholes when weather has permitted so, primarily focusing on Saskatchewan Avenue. We are fully aware of how rough the Highway through Town is at this time, and are making this our top priority over the next short while to finish patching the entire highway.

-Our staff have prepped and done maintenance on all our summer equipment (mowers etc.)

-All “digouts” in the streets that occurred late fall/winter have been maintained, and are included in our 2022 road patching projects.

-Virtue Construction has been contracted to do street sweeping mid April.

Environmental Health:

-The landfill has begun to see a large increase in waste coming out now that we are shifting out of the winter months. This increase is both in daily use from residents/users of the landfill, and also we have seen a large increase in volume waste picked up by the Towns regular garbage routes.

General Public Works:

-Work continues at the old depot building to utilize space more effectively, progress is coming along
