**Transportation:**

- We have started on back alley maintenance; grading, and adding gravel where needed with anticipation to have all complete prior to the street sweepers being in town.
- Virtue Construction is scheduled for street sweeping on May 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup>. Notice has been posted on our Facebook page, we are doing a mail drop also to remind residents to have their vehicles off the streets for these 2 days.
- We have started another round of pothole patching; starting on the highways, and will continue into residential streets.
- I have sent out requests for asphalt patching, and will present them to our CAO for discussion.
- We will be doing our sidewalk inspections this week and next to determine areas needing attention; pricing requests will be sent to our local contractors.

**Utilities:**

- All systems are currently operating as they should; river levels have been lower, but not to low to cause us any issues to date, hopefully they don't need to drop the flow much if any.
- We have our Water Security Agency inspection for both water, and wastewater scheduled for May 12 at 9:00.
- Brunners are scheduled to do the water main valve replacement on Sask Ave and Selkirk St on Tuesday May 18<sup>th</sup>; this does require the highway detour to be in place. They hope to also do some, or all of the sewer service connections that require action at this point as well.

**Environmental Health:**

- The landfill compactor has been taken out of service and is scheduled for repair on the brake, and hydraulic systems as early as next week, pending parts being in place.
- Update for the new development at the landfill; road work is complete to specs provided, we have started the renovations of the attendant building and have secured pricing for the plumbing portion of it, there are still some electrical work ongoing, we have a few building inspection deficiencies to address on the eco-center, but overall it is moving in a positive direction.

**General Public Works:**

- We have started mowing areas needing it, this will be ongoing now for the rest of the season.
- We have also started spraying for dandelions within our green spaces, and will be doing an early spray of weeds growing in the curbs to keep them at bay.
