Taxes are due **December 31, 2024**

Any accounts in arrears will incur a penalty of 10% on January 1st plus interest at 1.5% at every 1st of each month following until arrears are paid in full.

To avoid costly third party tax enforcement costs, ensure all arrears are paid prior to March 31, 2025. Pre-payments are always welcome!
