

Front street pickups will be done Monday's, with remaining street/alleys done throughout the week.

Compost can also be delivered to the Outlook Regional Landfill, free of charge.

Annual Maintenance Highlights

Each year the Town assess and prioritizes projects.

Public Works staff will be out and about this summer addressing potholes, painting crosswalks, curbs and stop blocks to ensure visibility and safety.

Inspections and repairs to address wear, cracking, and tripping hazards in the downtown brick sidewalks.

Ongoing street sweeping, tree trimming, and cemetery maintenance also continue.

Fire Hydrant and Water System Programs provide improvements towards water quality and system efficiency.

Older or malfunctioning fire hydrants are also identified and replaced annually.
