

## Free Landfill Days

The Town is pleased to offer free landfill Saturday's again this June! In an effort to protect our staff and residents, and to facilitate shorter wait times, we have scheduled the free landfill days according to the recycling pickup colored zones to reduce the amount of people at the landfill at one time.

**Saturday June 5<sup>th</sup> – Orange Zone**

**Saturday June 12<sup>th</sup> – Yellow Zone**

**Saturday June 19<sup>th</sup> – Green Zone**

**Saturday June 26<sup>th</sup> – Pink Zone**

Each household is limited to one free half-ton load at no charge. All loads must be sorted. Any additional loads or items will be charged at the regular rates. This applies to Town of Outlook residences only.

## Dutch Elm Disease

Dutch Elm Disease (DED) is caused by a fungus spread by tiny elm bark beetles that breed under the bark of dead or dying elm wood.

If that wood contains DED fungus, each new generation of beetles can infect healthy elms.

### **You can help prevent DED by;**

- Keep your own elm trees healthy;
- Do not prune Elm trees from April 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>;
- If you see signs of DED, report them to the Public Works Department;
- Don't buy, sell, store, transport or use elm firewood; it is illegal;
- Remove and dispose of the tree promptly if DED is confirmed;
- Support DED management in your community.

The town will be marking and inspecting trees infected with Dutch Elm Disease throughout the season.

## 2021 Fence Requirements

Development permits for fences are **no longer required** by the Town of Outlook, Bylaw No. 27(2020).

It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure that your fence placement does not encroach an adjacent property.

Any fence found to be encroaching on an adjacent property will be removed at the expense of the landowner found to be in violation.

Should a dispute arise between property owners on the placement of a fence, a legal land survey will need to be completed at the expense of the landowners.

### **Branch Pick Up**

Branch pick up will be take place following the following days:

### **Compost Pick Up**

Compost pick up will begin the first week of April.

Lawn clippings, leaves and other garden refuse may be left in a brown compostable paper bag, neat pile or placed in a bin with the lid off.

We do prefer that compost not be placed in plastic bags as they tend to blow away after they have been emptied. If you do have the compost in a bag, please leave it open so that it can be distinguished from regular garbage.

Please have compost ready for pick-up by 8:00am Monday mornings to ensure pick-up during the week.

### **Bagged Household Garbage**

Double bag any household garbage that has liquid contents or items that may leak.

Please keep all garbage bags to a manageable weight.

Remember public works staff are hand lifting 100% of the garbage bags each week.

### Property Assessments 2021

SAMA conducts revaluations based on a four-year cycle.

2017 was the year of the last revaluation, and the 2021 revaluation will see assessed values updated to reflect a new base date of January 1, 2019.

The legislated base date means that 2021 values reflect a property's value as of January 1, 2019.

Every property owner will receive an Assessment Notice showing the updated values to their property.
