

Sealed bids marked "Bid for Town of Outlook, Wood Chipping at Landfill" will be received at the Town of Outlook Municipal Office, 400 Saskatchewan Avenue West, or mailed to PO Box 518, Outlook, Saskatchewan, S0L 2N0 up to **4:00 pm, September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019**. Bids will be opened and read at the Town Council Meeting on Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The work involves on-site chipping of existing mixed wood pile at the Town of Outlook Landfill located at NW 11-29-08 W 3 with on-site stockpiling of chips. Wood chips may be coarsely shredded as they will only be used for cover in the landfill cell.

The project will be supervised by the Superintendent of Public Works.

**Saskatchewan Workers Compensation Letter of Good Standing** and **proof of liability insurance** must be included with the bid in order for it to be considered.

Contractors must ensure all workers, and subcontractors, are certified Powered Mobile Equipment operators under Occupational Health and Safety where required and that all workers and subcontractors follow regulations set out by Occupational Health and Safety as required.
