


TOWN OF OUTLOOK
BYLAW NO. 3(88)

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK TO PROVIDE PROTECTION AND UNAUTHORIZED
ENTRY ONTO TOWN OWNED PROPERTY.


This Bylaw may be cited as the "Trespassing Bylaw."

The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan,
enacts as follows:

1. The usual hours of operation of the Administration Office, Utility Plants, Transportation Services (Buildings and Compound), Waste Disposal Site, are Monday thru Friday (except Statutory or Civic Holidays), between the hours of 8 A.M. and 5 P.M. unless otherwise posted.
2. No Person shall enter any Town land that is roped, barricaded, fenced or indicated by notice or sign prohibiting entrance to the land unless prior written or verbal authorization had been received from a Town Official.
3. No Person shall enter or be found within any Town Building in the absence of Town personnel, unless prior written or verbal authorization had been received from a Town Official.
4. Subject to Section 5, any person found within the Administration Office, Utility Plants, Transportation Services (Buildings and Compound), Waste Disposal Site, any time except during the hours of operation as set out in Section 1, shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw.
5. This Bylaw shall not apply to service or maintenance personnel, either employees of the Municipality or under contract with the Municipality.
6. Any Person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the Municipality or other specified penalty.
