

**TOWN OF OUTLOOK
BYLAW NO. 03 (2020)**

**A BYLAW TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR PRIVATE UTILITY CONNECTION DEPOSITS, AND TO
FIX THE RATES FOR DISCONNECTION AND RECONNECTION OF PRIVATE UTILITY CONNECTIONS IN THE
TOWN OF OUTLOOK.**

The Council of the Town of Outlook, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

INTRODUCTION AND DEFINITIONS

1. Title

This Bylaw may be cited as “The Utility Connections Bylaw”.

2. Definitions

In this Bylaw,

“MUNICIPALITY” means the Town of Outlook.

“COUNCIL” means the Council of the Town of Outlook.

“ADMINISTRATOR” means the Administrator or Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Outlook.

“CURB STOP” means a valve typically located at the property line for the purpose of controlling the flow of potable water from the water main to the property. Curb stops are the property of the Town of Outlook.

3. Purpose

The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish the deposit fees charged for private utility connections, and to establish a procedure for the disconnection of water services due to non-payment, and to establish disconnection and reconnection charges.

4. Application

Every person desiring to have his/her premises connected to the waterworks system shall apply to the Town for that service.
