Water Main Flushing

The Town of Outlook would like to advise all its residents that the Public Works Department will be conducting Water Main Flushing during the hours of 8am to 5pm from May 19th – 22nd, 2020.

Water main flushing is an important part of water distribution maintenance as it aids in the improvement of drinking water. Flushing involves isolating a section of the water distribution system and opening hydrants to release water at a high flow rate. The increased water flow aids in the removal of material that has built up over time in the water mains.

Residents may experience loss of water pressure or a brief period of no water. When the water pressure does return, you may experience the water supply showing sediment and/or discoloration.

The sediment / discoloration is harmless, however it can cause discoloration to laundry, therefore, residents are encouraged not to wash clothes or use bleach during these hours.

If you experience discoloured water, just run your taps until the water runs clear.
