

Bylaw No. 04(2017)

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OUTLOOK TO AMEND BYLAW 08(2014) KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Outlook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw 08(2014) as follows:

Part I

1. In General Regulations –Section 4 ss 4.6.2. Permitted Obstructions ss (2)(b): the distance of 0.6 meters is removed and replaced with the distance of 1.828 meters.


Part II

2. In Section 2 – Interpretation – the following definition shall be included:
Sign, Sandwich Board: A sandwich board is a freestanding temporary sign, with no moving parts or lights, no larger than 0.65 square meters total sign size; displayed outside a business, during business hours, to advertise the business, hours of operation, an event, a promotion, etc., (excluding real estate signage) It is not intended as permanent business signage. One sandwich board sign, per street frontage.
3. Section 4.10 Signs is amended as follows: 4.10.9 Portable Sign Regulations is amended to read: "**Portable Sign & Sandwich Board Regulations**"
4. Section 4.10.9 Portable Sign & Sandwich Board Regulations is amended by adding the following: **5. Sandwich Board Location:** Signs may be placed on a sidewalk directly in front of the associated establishment. The sign shall be placed on that part of the sidewalk closest to the associated use and the nearest part of the sign structure shall not be separated by more than 0.6 meters from the wall of the building. The sign must be placed so as not to interfere with or obstruct pedestrian or vehicular traffic. Signs may not be anchored to the sidewalk, or attached or chained to poles, newspaper vending boxes, or other structures or appurtenances. **6. Sandwich Board Size:** Any sandwich board sign shall not exceed 0.6 meters in width, with a maximum height of 1.07 meters. Within these specified maximum dimensions, creative shapes that reflect the theme of the business are encouraged (i.e., ice cream shops may display a sign in the shape of an ice cream cone). **7. Appearance:** The sign must be constructed of materials that present a finished appearance. Rough-cut plywood is not acceptable. The sign frame shall be painted or stained wood or anodized aluminum or metal. Plastic framed signs are prohibited. Stenciled or spray painted signs are prohibited. Windblown devices, including balloons, may not be attached or otherwise made part of the sign The sign lettering should be professionally painted or applied; a "yard sales" or "graffiti" look with hand painted or paint stenciled letters is not acceptable, however, chalkboard signs shall be permitted. The


written message of the sign should be kept to the minimum necessary

to communicate the name of the business or a special message of the business. Lettering on the sign shall be small enough to not be legible from automobile traffic on the street. 8. **Lighting and Display Hours:** Signs may not be illuminated. The sign shall be removed at the end of the business day and will **only** be displayed during regular business hours.

5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final approval of the Council.


