

Public Works Report

October 6, 2025

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Transportation:

- We had our 2nd dust control application on our gravel roads in late August, with the dreaded winter arriving soon potentially, we will be out grading in the near future to prepare.
- All contracted street patching is done for the year, we will be doing another town blitz for any potholes, and patch up any manhole covers and valve boxes which are sticking up.
- Alley maintenance has been ongoing, and all are in pretty decent shape.

Utilities:

- We started our secondary lagoon discharge early September, it is ongoing; first set of samples has been sent to the lab, and we will be required to do another set as our discharge period will be over 1 month in duration.
- We had our annual WSA inspections recently on both water and wastewater systems, both were well with minor issues arising.

Environmental Health:

- Landfill operations are going as normal according to our permit to operate; we have had to utilize both public works, and office staff to help cover as we are still looking for another employee.
- Earlier in the year, we had a full operations audit on our landfill by the ministry of the Environment; there were no major issues found, and nearly all minor issues that were stated have already been remedied.

General Public Works

- We are currently on what will likely be our last mowing rotation for the year as the grass has nearly stopped growing.
- Compost and branch pickup will continue until the snow flies.
- In the near future, we will be preparing for the winter months; mixing salt and sand, getting sand truck ready, and grader ready for snow removal
