## GARBAGE & COMPOST

- Branch pick up is finished for this year. Watch for dates in the January Newsletter on when 2020 pick will resume
- Compost pick up for the weeks of October 14<sup>th</sup> and November 11<sup>th</sup> will occur on Tuesday rather than the usual Monday, weather permitting. As soon as there is significant snowfall, compost pick up will cease.
- As a reminder, you may take your branches, clean wood and compost to the landfill any time at no charge
- Christmas garbage pick up for those who would have pick up on Tuesday December 24<sup>th</sup>, will occur instead on Monday December 23<sup>rd</sup>, and those who would have on Wednesday December 25<sup>th</sup>, will happen instead on Friday December 27<sup>th</sup>.
- New Years garbage pick up for those who would have on Wednesday January 1<sup>st</sup>, will occur instead on Thursday January 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- A Reminder to all residents that burning leaves, etc is not allowed within town limits.
