## **Garbage, Recycling and Compost**

- Branch pick up is finished for the year; watch for dates in the January newsletter for 2021 branch pick ups. As a friendly reminder, you can still take your branches, clean wood, and compost to the landfill during landfill hours at no charge.
- Compost pick up will continue as usual until such time that there is significant snowfall, then compost pick up will cease. During fall months compost pick up is conducted as often as possible, but may get behind some weeks due to reduced staffing, and we appreciate your patience.
- A reminder to all residents that burning leaves is not permitted within Town limits.
- Recycling pickup scheduled for Friday December 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 has been rescheduled to December 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020. January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 recycling pick up is to stay as scheduled. The 2021 Recycling Pickup Schedule will soon be arriving, watch for it in your mailbox!
- You can no longer take glass to the concrete bunker next to the old recycle depot. All glass needs to be bagged with your regular household garbage. Please remember that garbage has a 50lb per bag weight limit.
