Fall Clean Up

Fall is an excellent time for tree trimming and yard clean up!

There are many trees growing into the back alleys making it difficult to drive down with municipal vehicles and equipment without risk of damage. In addition, there are many weeds and overgrown grasses neglected in the back alleys that will collect snow and could cause unnecessary storm water damage to alleys and private property this winter and next spring. Please take this opportunity to clean up your yard along the alley to prevent damage and/or the appearance of neglect. We appreciate everyone's efforts to keep our community clean and tidy!

<u>Compost</u>

Compost pick up will continue as usual until there is significant snowfall. During fall months compost pick up is conducted as often as possible, but may get behind some weeks due to reduced staffing, and we appreciate your patience.

As a reminder, the landfill accepts: clean wood, leaves, and compost year-round, at no charge to residents, and that burning leaves and yard waste is not permitted within Town limits.

Garbage

Please ensure that your household waste is put in the correct place for pickup on your designated garbage day. Please remember that garbage has a 50lb per bag weight limit.

Construction waste, electronics, appliances, recyclable materials, loose items and large items are <u>not</u> considered household waste. Staff will not pick these up. Please deliver these items to the landfill yourself.
