

# Highway 45

## Thin Membrane Surface Upgrade near Lake Diefenbaker



### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Ministry of Highways plans to build a new surfacing structure on Highway 45 for approximately 27 km between the junctions with Highways 44 and 15. This project is part of the Government of Saskatchewan's investment in improving safety and efficiency on key highway corridors.

The estimated cost of this project is \$22.8 million.

Project start: April 2022

Project specified completion date: November 2022



### TRAFFIC IMPACT

You can expect minor delays and disruptions along Highway 45. Traffic through the work zone will be one-way and will be at a reduced speed of 60 km/h. Flaggers will be present and traffic may be stopped for no longer than 20 minutes. Traffic information will be available throughout the project on the Highway
